

We live in a magnificent area of the UK. However, our local services have not seen a rise in funding owing to outdated formulas.

We have been campaigning for fairer funding formulas and we have seen an increase in education funding. This is, however, not enough and I will work with Anthony Browne MP to achieve a fairer settlement figure.

Investing now for the future

‘The Hub construction remains on programme for completion in Spring 2021 with the foundations for the building now complete and the steel framed structure currently being erected. The project is also on budget with much greater certainty around costs now that the project has reached this stage in the construction.

With regards to the disposal of Shire Hall, we are now very close to finalising Heads of Term’s with the developer. This follows robust discussions to ensure best value to CCC while maintaining key principles around the sensitive development of the site and continued public access’.

We will be securing over £40m in the bid for our Shire Hall building. Re-Investing in other projects and front line services

Mobile and Broadband coverage

This is extremely important for working and socializing. In times of crisis we have seen that it is even more important.

I have been asking residents about this and taking action. We are investing millions of pounds at County Council to find a solution.

Highlights

I jointly led, with Steve Count, Leader of the Council, our Environment & Climate Change Strategy and secured the following pledges:

- Reduce the Council's carbon footprint by 50% on 2018-19 levels by 2023.
- Adapt our services to manage the impacts of climate change to benefit service users
- Improve air quality, increase biodiversity and natural capital across our estate and wildlife sites;
- Work with our supply chain to deliver 50% reduction on our 'scope 3' carbon emissions by 2030;
- Develop all Council strategies to include policies to tackle Climate Change and enhance our natural capital;
- Collaborate with Cambridgeshire businesses, residents and the public sector to deliver our ambitious targets, and net zero carbon by 2050
- Work with Government, partners and stakeholders to support the 10,000 homes dependent on oil for heating and hot water in Cambridgeshire to switch to 100% clean energy by 2050

Conservative led achievements:

- ✓ Over £10m generated per annum from commercial activity straight into front-line services.
- ✓ +7000 tons of carbon reduction measures already delivered and will increase to 16,000 tons within 3 years
- ✓ £8.5m of Public Health budget for school nursing and health visitors to support our Children and Families Strategy
