You will have seen that East West Rail (EWR) are proposing to build a high-speed railway around our wonderful rural village and surrounding farmland via an embankment which will be 30ft above ground level and routed across Washpit Lane and Haslingfield Road that links Harlton and Haslingfield.

The Parish Council have been heavily involved with Cambridge Approaches (CA), the local campaign organisation set up to work with Parish Councils and other action groups. CA is preparing a case for judicial review of EWR's decisions, and they have asked that at the moment we as a PC and individual villagers hold off on any direct response to the EWR consultation while their legal team review all the documentation, and gauge the best way forward.

We will be holding a full village Zoom meeting in order to update the village on actions that are available and establish what our combined response should be.
