Environmental Catastrophe

This would see 271,000 new houses built in Cambridgeshire and 1 million across the whole Arc, leading to massive environmental destruction and overdevelopment.

TIMELINE

In 2017 - Government company East West Rail Co takes control of delivery of the railway and is given remit to build only as far as Cambridge Central Station.

They reject appeals to consider a Northern route.

In 2019 - EWR Company holds first consultation on the <u>Southern corridor only</u> and 5 Routes were put forward.

In 2020 - East West Rail Co announces that the Southern route is their choice into Cambridge.

Many people feel the consultation process has failed and the correct considerations have not been applied.



- 1 Approx 17km of embankments, viaducts and bridges, up to 12metres high, 'The Great Wall of Cambridgeshire' between Cambourne and the south of Harston. Plus a cutting through Chapel Hill about 40metres wide.
- 2 New junction with existing railway south of Harston, requiring massive concrete flyover.
- **3** Four tracks required between Shepreth Junction (in Gt Shelford) and to the north of Long Road bridge, Cambridge.
- 4 A Southern Approach into Cambridge will force all Felixstowe trains, including freight, round Coldhams Common curve and through Cherry Hinton and Newmarket. Dualling of track also required.
- 5 There are eight level crossings between Cambridge and Newmarket. Some will be closed, others replaced with bridges.
- 6 Single track Warren Hill Tunnel at Newmarket, with restricted height.
- **7** Existing Freight route from Felixstowe, passing through Ely. Ely is operating at full capacity.
- 8 Railway hidden using low impact 'Trench Technology' suitable for floodplains.
- **9** Railway passes below A14, no bridges or embankments required.
- 10 New lowered station for Northstowe.
- **11** New connecting chord (track) for freight trains over open fields. Avoids Cambridge.
