WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 - SECTION 53**

The Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way in Cambridgeshire
Relevant date: 11th May 2016

**The Cambridgeshire County Council (Public Footpath No. 8, Harlton) Definitive Map
Modification Order 2021**

The above Order made on 14 July 2021, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding to them a footpath commencing at a junction with Public Footpath No. 1, Harlton at OSGR TL 38768 52660 (point A on the map) generally south south west for approximately 4 metres to a field gate at OSGR TL 38767 52656 (point B on the map). Continuing generally south south west across a field for approximately 104 metres to a stile in the northern boundary of St Mary's Church at OSGR TL 38742 52554 (point C on the map).

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at Comberton Library, Comberton Village College, West Street, Comberton, CB23 7DU between the hours of 10am and 2pm on Mondays and 1pm and 5pm on Wednesdays and Fridays. Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to the undersigned not later than 8 September 2021, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representation or objection is duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Cambridgeshire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
